1. **Product** Emollin
2. **Category** Emollient
3. **Presentation** Aerosol Sizes 50ml, 150ml & 240ml

4. Description

A topical multi-dose aerosol containing a mix of White Soft Paraffin BP and Light Liquid Paraffin BP in a volatile silicone base. The aerosol is a bag-in-can type pressurised with Nitrogen.

5. Hazards Identification

6. Ingredients

White Soft Paraffin BP, Light Liquid Paraffin BP, Hexamethyldisiloxane

7. First Aid Measures

Eye/Skin Contact: In case of contact with eyes, immediately flush with water. Consult a physician. In case of skin irritation, discontinue contact and flush skin with water.

Inhalation: Remove from exposure to fresh air and consult a physician.

8. Fire Fighting Measures

- Extinguishing materials: Water, Foam, Carbon Dioxide, Dry Chemical.
- Protection of Firefighters: Wear self-contained breathing apparatus and protective clothing.
- Hazards from Combustion: Incomplete burning can produce carbon monoxide and/or carbon dioxide and hazardous gases.
- Precautions: Remove containers from path of fire. Heating can cause expansion and rupture of containers. Keep containers cool with water.

9. Handling and Storage

Take care if product comes into contact with floor or other hard surface – hazard of slipping. Do not spray near or into the eyes. Keep out of the reach of children. Use with adequate ventilation. Do not store where temperatures may exceed 50 degrees centigrade. Do not puncture or burn, even when empty. Observe local aerosol disposal regulations.

Transport: Although Emollin spray does not contain flammable propellants – it is classed as an aerosol and is classified as for transportation under Dangerous Goods UN 1950 2.1 “Limited quantity” being under 0.5L

10. Toxicological Information

Toxic acute or chronic reactions are not anticipated from use following label instructions. Does not contain any known skin sensitisers.

11. Regulatory Information

The Medical device is classified as class I according to MDD 93/42 EEC.
